

Skater of the Year Qualification Guidelines



The intention of Lone Star Figure Skating Club Skater of the Year award is to recognize members who have shown strength, commitment, and perseverance, both on and off the ice. The following guidelines have been established to help ensure all nominees are evaluated fairly and equally. The selection committee will evaluate all nominations that meet these minimum requirements.

- 1) Nominee must be a Lone Star Figure Skating Club Learn To Skate member (Basic Skills) or Full Member. Associate Members are not eligible.
- 2) Awards are presented for the following categories:
 - a. Learn to Skate (Snowplow Sam through No Test)
 - b. Non-Qualifying (Pre-Preliminary through Pre-Juvenile)
 - c. Qualifying (Juvenile through Senior)
 - d. Adult (All levels, including Learn to Skate)
- 3) Skater must have been a member of LSFSC for the full 2017-2018 season
- 4) Learn To Skate members are eligible if they began their initial skating membership with Lone Star FSC at anytime during the season.
- 5) Current members who transferred after January 1, 2018 are not eligible.
- 6) Any adult Lone Star FSC member can nominate a skater.
- 7) Parents cannot nominate their own child.
- 8) Coaches may nominate their own skaters.
- 9) An adult may submit more than one nomination.
- 10) All nominations must include the official nomination form and must be submitted by the April 17th deadline.
